

Thanks to our strict protocols we were granted the Safe Travels badge and diverse certifications in each country in which we are located.



On February 14th, Dolphin Discovery Los Cabos, our natural habitat located in San Jose del Cabo, Baja California Sur, celebrated 10 years of having opened its doors. Since then, more than 200,000 visitors from the U.S., Mexico, Canada, and elsewhere, have lived The Experience of a Lifetime through its educational interactions with species such as dolphins, sea lions and dromedaries.

MARINA AQUATOURS LAUNCHES A NEW AND INCREDIBLE AQUATIC TOUR:

This guided tour is onboard of powerful boats with capacity for 14 passengers, who will enjoy a fun and fast adventure between the channels of the Nichupte Lagoon and through the Caribbean Sea. Our boats have Zodiac engines, which makes them especially powerful and fast, and most importantly they are unique in the destination.

The tour lasts 3 hours and includes a speedy ride through the Nichupte Lagoon and snorkeling at two different points: El Barco Hundido, where you will be able to snorkel around a sunken ship, and El Meco, a natural reef in the Caribbean Sea.

ANNOUNCES THE BIRTH OF A BABY MANATEE

Veterinarians and Specialists from our habitat Dolphin Discovery Puerto Aventuras, assisted the birth of a beautiful female manatee, Julieta's calf, the first manatee rescued by our incredible Rescue Team in 2001.

This calf is the 12th manatee born at Dolphin Discovery thanks to our "Miracle" breeding program. Manatees are in danger of extinction thus births in human care contribute to the repopulation of the species.

To share the good news with our audience, we launched a facebook contest to name the newest member of our family. Our newborn manatee is now proudly called **Zaázil.**





A SOUTH AMERICAN FUR SEAL INTO THE OCEAN

Our team of Marine Mammal Specialists and Veterinarians from Aquarium Mar del Plata, our marine park in Argentina, successfully reintegrated a male juvenile South American Fur Seal into the sea; after he recovered from a severe malnutrition.

After more than a month of treatment that included vitamins, blood tests, medications, and a lot of effort from our Specialists and Veterinarians, "Peque", as he was named, remarkably regained weight and reached almost 16 kg.



Since 1994, Aquarium Mar del Plata has a Marine Fauna Rehabilitation Center (CRFM) in which it carries out research, education and environmental protection activities, contributing to the rehabilitation of more than 5,000 animals including penguins, pinnipeds, sea turtles, and coastal seabirds.
