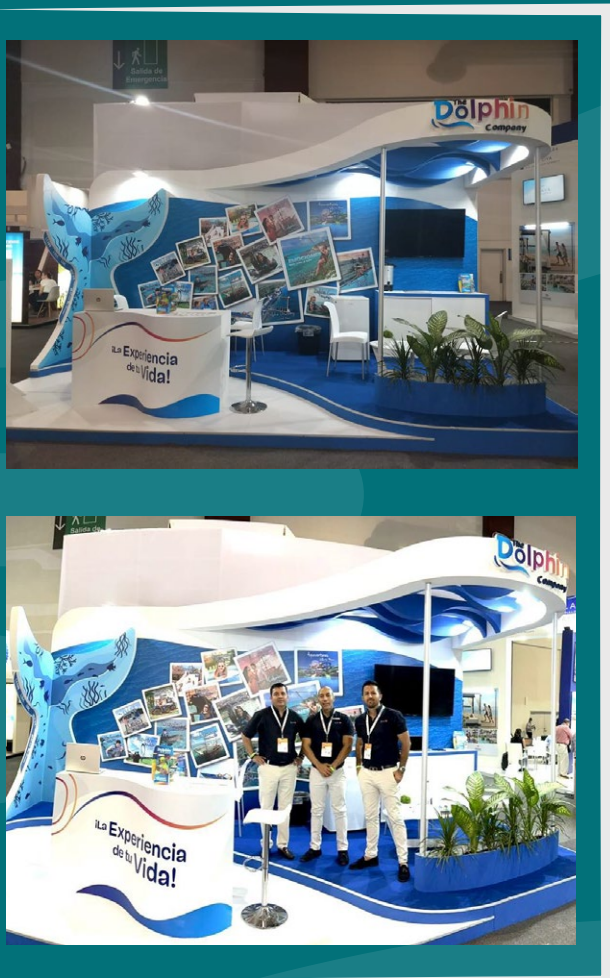

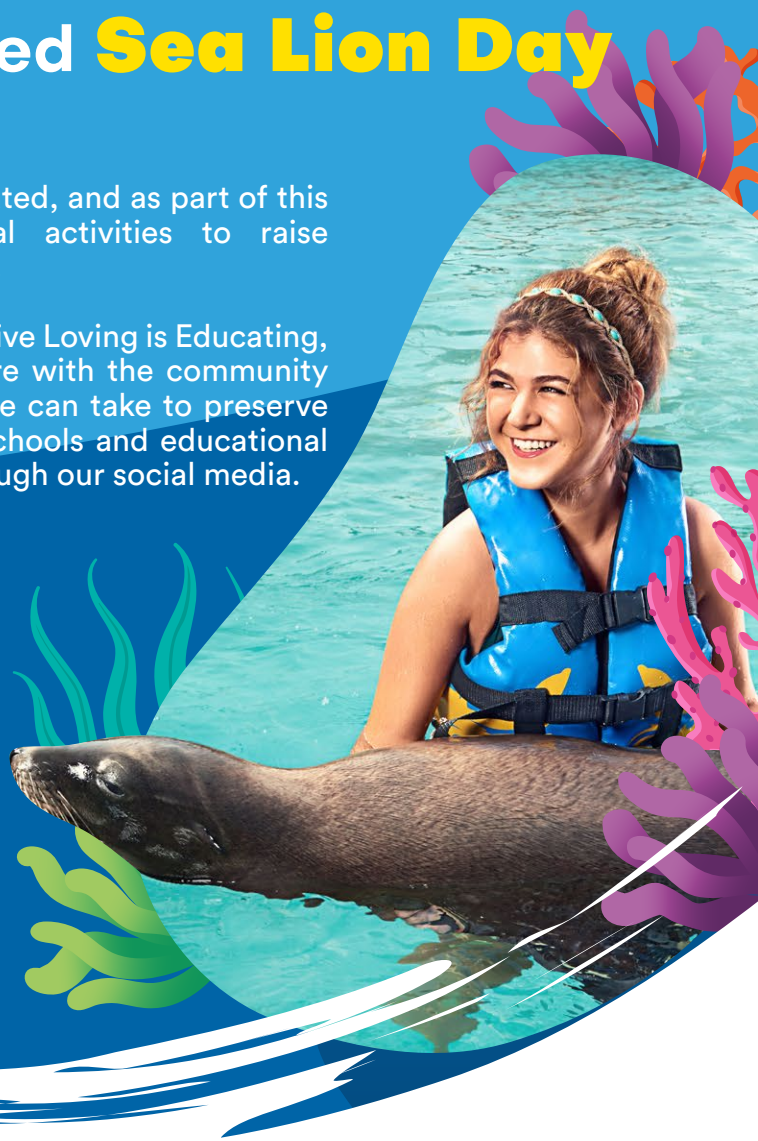

Dolphin Discovery celebrated **Sea Lion Day**

Every year, on May 30th, Sea Lion Day is commemorated, and as part of this celebration, Dolphin Discovery developed several activities to raise awareness about the importance of their preservation.

The Sea Lion week was carried out as part of the initiative Loving is Educating, in which educational activities are developed to share with the community interesting facts about the species and the actions we can take to preserve them. As part of the activities, visits were made to schools and educational information was provided within our Habitats and through our social media.

We currently have more than 40 Sea Lions of different species in our care, in our Habitats at Dolphin Discovery in Cozumel, Isla Mujeres, Puerto Aventuras, Vallarta and Los Cabos; as well as in Gulf World in the United States, Aquarium in Argentina and Zoomarine in Italy.

On April 29th, the Fauna Rehabilitation Center (CRFM) of Aquarium Mar del Plata reintroduced ten Magellanic Penguins to the sea. Thanks to the work done by our Biologists, Veterinarians, and the Technical Team of the CRFM, the Penguins were rehabilitated and reintegrated into their habitat, after spending 60 days under the care of our Specialists.

celebrated **84** years of making history

Marineland, our multi-experience Park located in St Augustine, United States, celebrated its 84th anniversary on June 23rd. The Park, which began in 1938 as a film studio, is considered the first oceanarium in the world.

Throughout these 84 years it has contributed to research and discoveries about the interaction of humans with Dolphins; as well as the care and preservation of this and other species.

Thanks to its high standards in animal care, it has several international certifications such as the Alliance of Marine Mammal Parks and Aquariums (AMMPA), International Marine Animal Trainers' Association (IMATA), American Humane Certified (AHC) and Association of Zoos and Aquariums (AZA).

It is part of The Dolphin Company since 2019, and we are pleased to share with them the vision of preservation and to be able to carry out actions that reinforce our love and respect for animals and the environment.



RECEIVED ANIMAL WELFARE ACCREDITATIONS
